

2019 HATCHING EGG PRODUCTION

Manitoba hatching egg production increased by 1.79% from 2018, resulting in a quota utilization of 104.90%. Domestic egg hatchability was increased by 1.2% from the previous year. Imported eggs decreased by 6.52% and imported chicks increased by 19.10% compared to 2018. The percentage of Manitoba chicks placed in Manitoba increased 1.0%.
