2021 HATCHING EGG PRODUCTION

Manitoba hatching egg production decreased by 0.87% from 2020, resulting in a quota utilization of 101.23%. Domestic egg hatchability was increased by 0.7% from the previous year. Imported eggs increased by 20.57% and imported chicks increased by 39.3% compared to 2020. The percentage of Manitoba chicks placed in Manitoba decreased 2.2%.
