

2023 HATCHING EGG PRODUCTION

Manitoba hatching egg production increased by 9.02% from 2022, resulting in a quota utilization of 103.22%. Domestic egg hatchability was decreased by 1.1% from the previous year. Imported eggs decreased by 33.50% and imported chicks decreased by 99.73% compared to 2022. The percentage of Manitoba chicks placed in Manitoba increased 5.3%.
